A. First- and second-year ARTF courses consist of 12 hours of studio classes plus 12 hours of independent studio activities per week; third-year ARTF courses consist of 12 hours of studio classes plus 15 hours of independent studio activities per week; and fourth-year ARTF courses consist of 24 hours

of independent studio activities plus 1 hour of individual instruction per week, and 9 hours of seminars.

B. (ARTH 226 and ARTH 228) or ARTH 232 are recommended courses for Supporting **2.B.**

C. A maximum of 6.00 units from courses offered by other Faculties and Schools may be counted toward the program and/or Plan requirements. This includes courses in BMED, COMM, GLPH, HSCI, LAW, NURS, and courses in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science.
