The requirements of the MA are 3 Core Courses listed below + 2 electives + Thesis or Project (SCCS 899). The MA thesis is approximately 15000 words in length and should be finished and defended before a committee within the year.

THESIS

The MA thesis requirement can take any of the four following formats, depending on the focus of the student:

- 1. a traditional 15000 word thesis;
- 2. a media work with a 5000 word companion document situating the work into larger debates in the field;
- 3. a curatorial project/installation with a 5000 word companion document situating the work into larger debates in the field; and
- 4. a video essay synthesizing studies, curatorial and production questions, a 5000 word companion document situating the work into larger debates in the field.
